Alfred Stieglitz

Alfred Stieglitz was born on January 1, 1864 in Hoboken, New Jersey. Stieglitz is famous for being one of the first artists to use Photography as a form of expression. He traveled extensively in Europe, and was instrumental in creating a place for American photographers in the art world. He established one of the first magazines to focus on photography and later opened his own art gallery in New York City, that launched the careers of many famous and important artists, including Georgia O'Keeffe who he later married.
